- ✦ Driven by a need for small Charter High School Option in Douglas County
 - Strong evidence of local support.
 - Provides unique programming, transitioning from a Core Knowledge K-8 Curriculum to a “Classical Model”.
 - Strong evidence of sound Financial and Facilities Planning.
